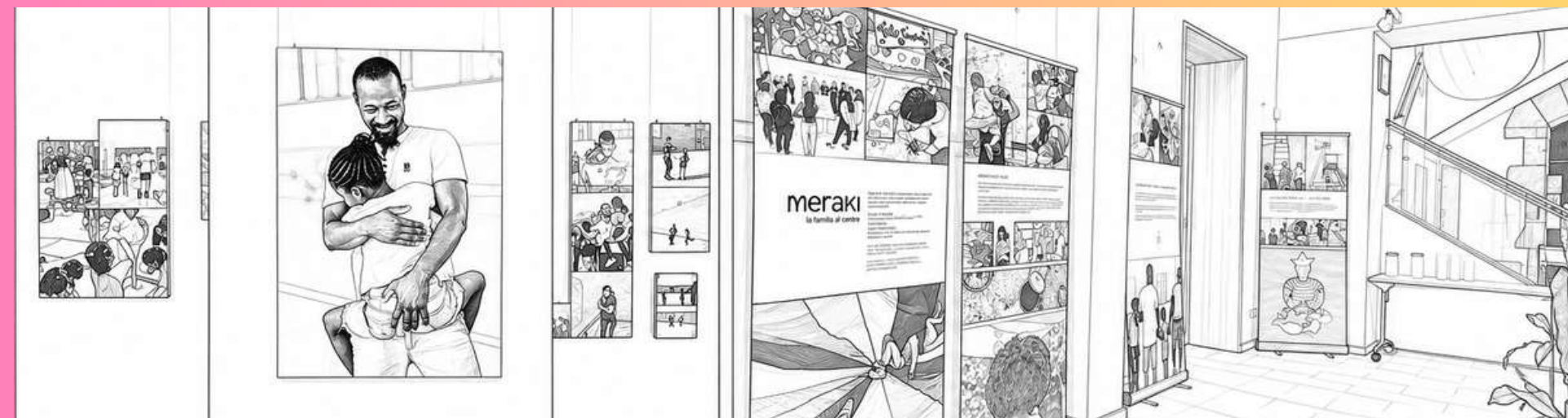

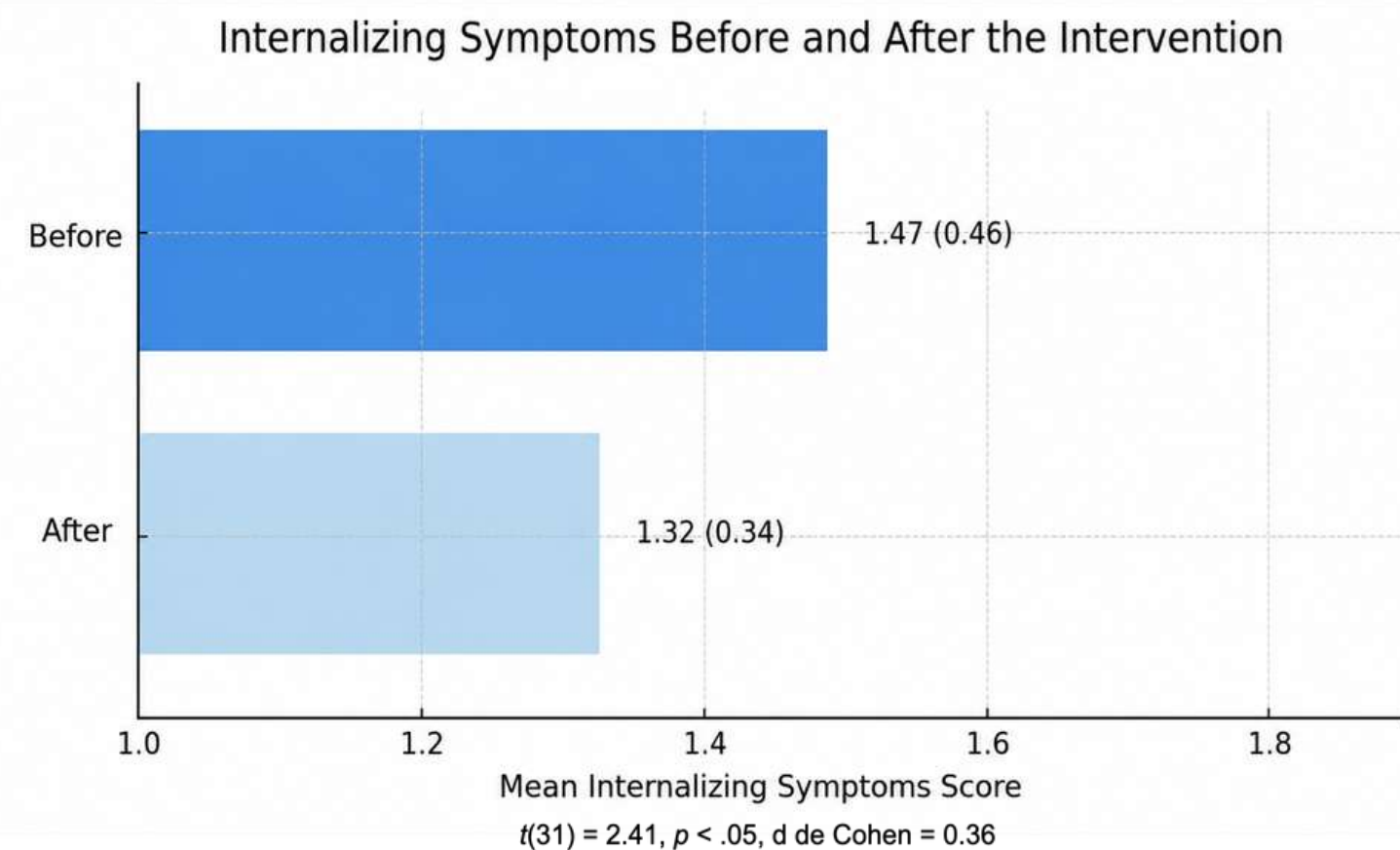

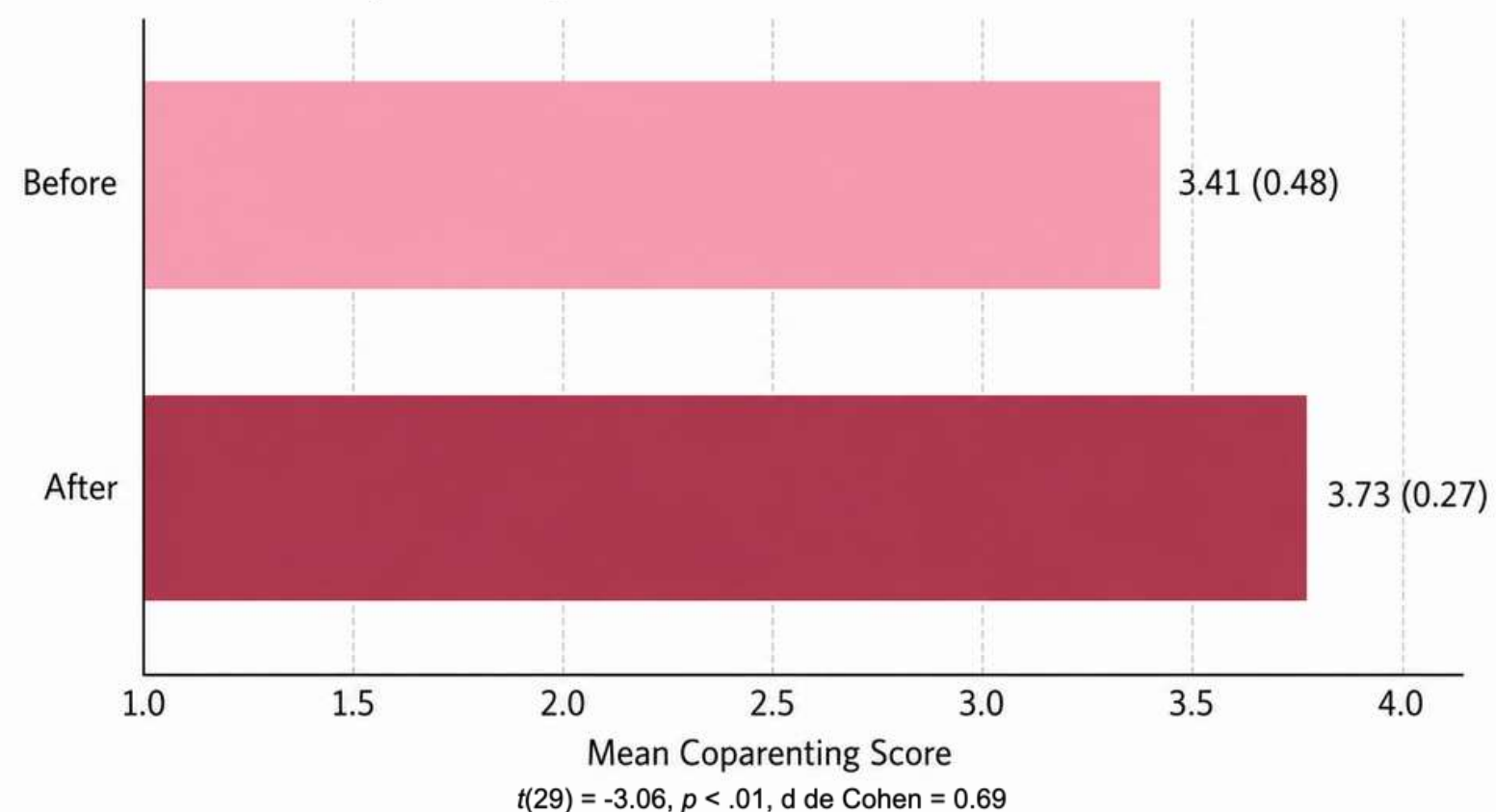

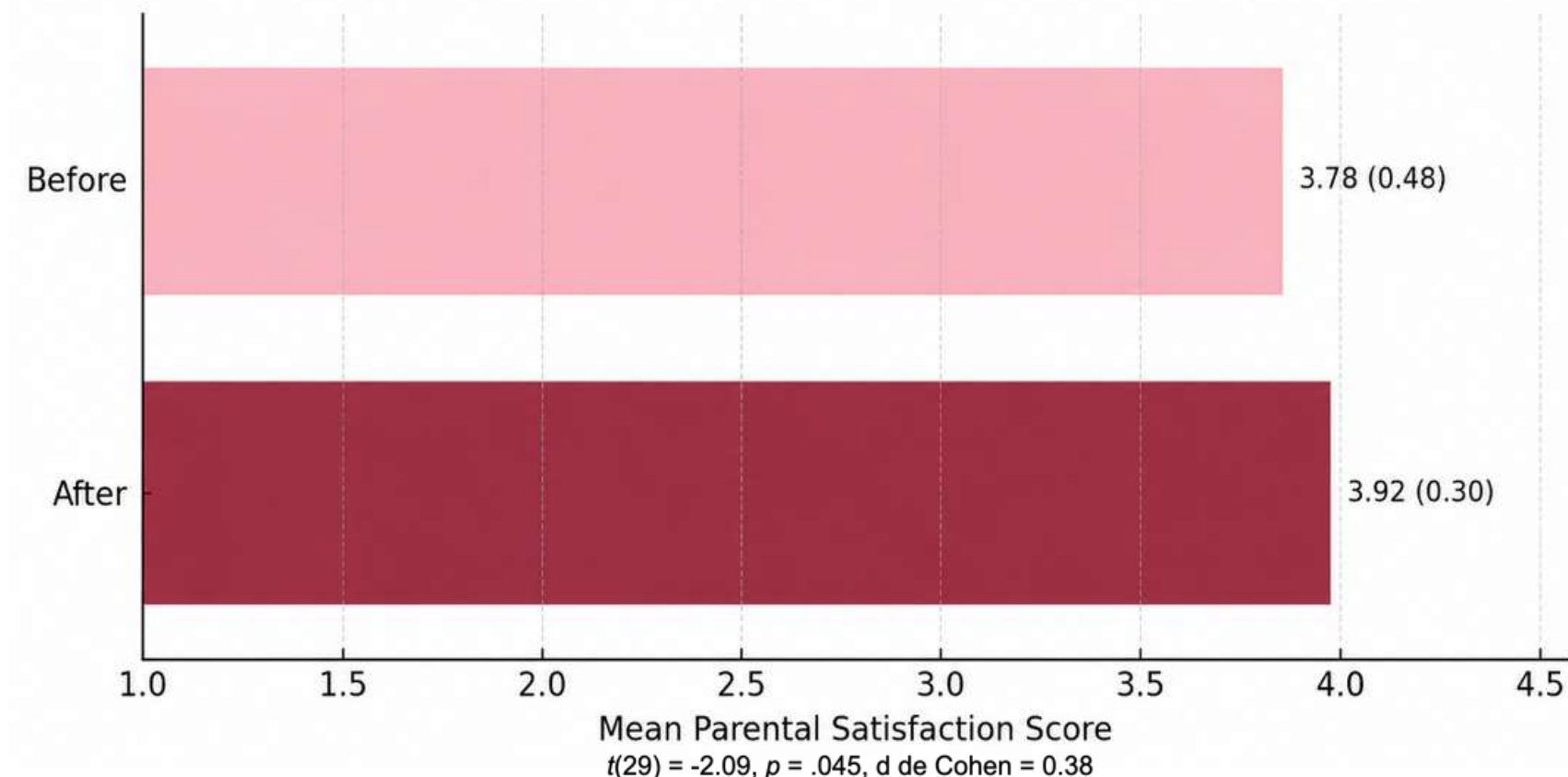

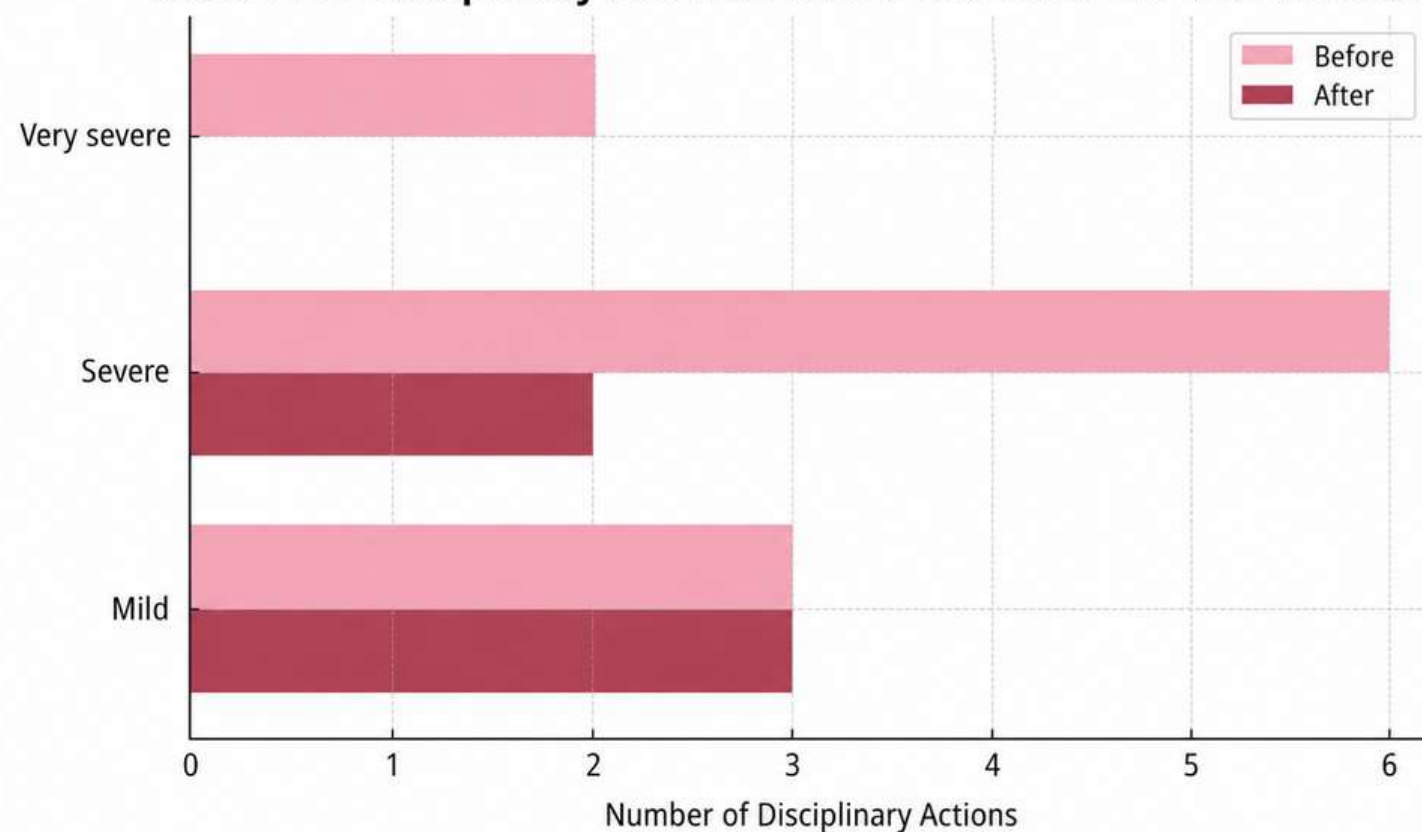
Coparenting Before and After the Intervention



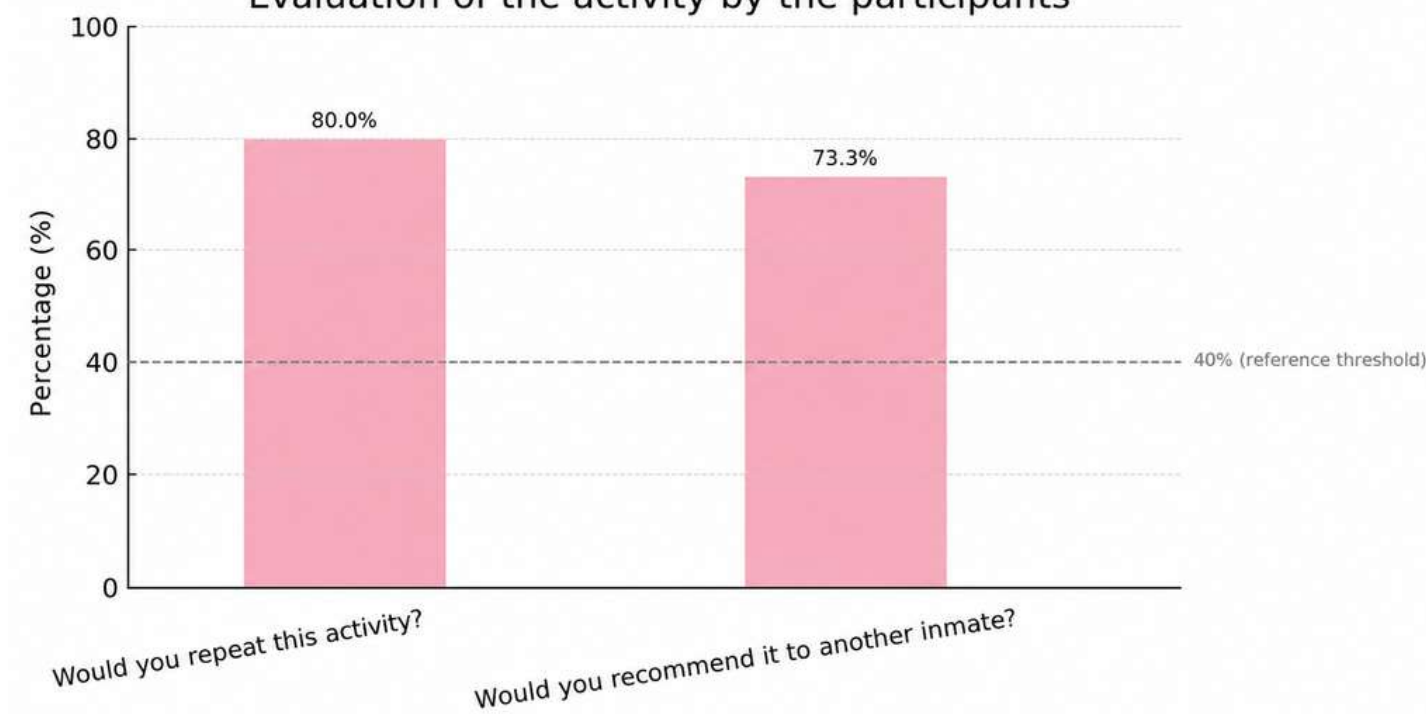
Parental Satisfaction Before and After the Intervention



Number of Disciplinary Actions Before and After the Intervention

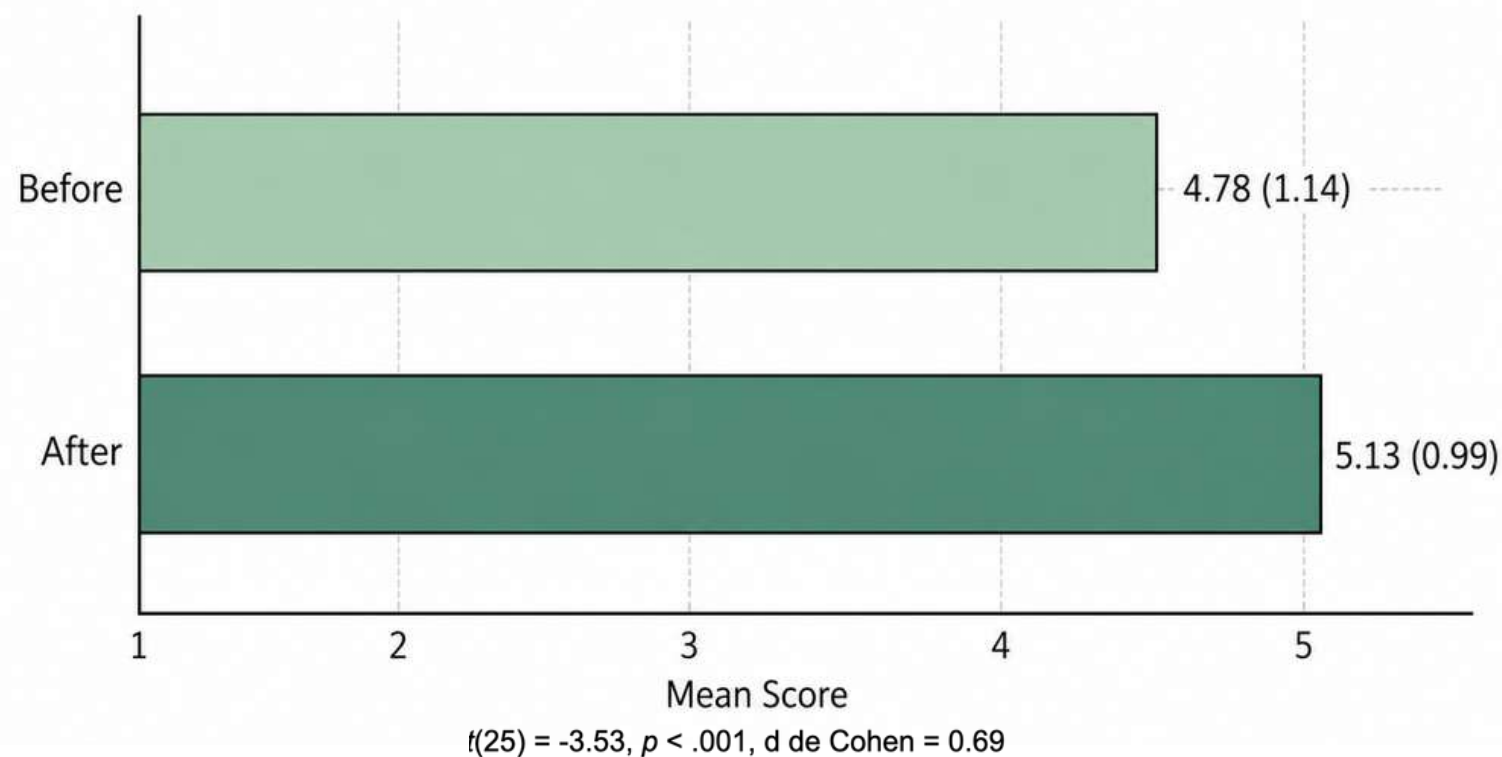

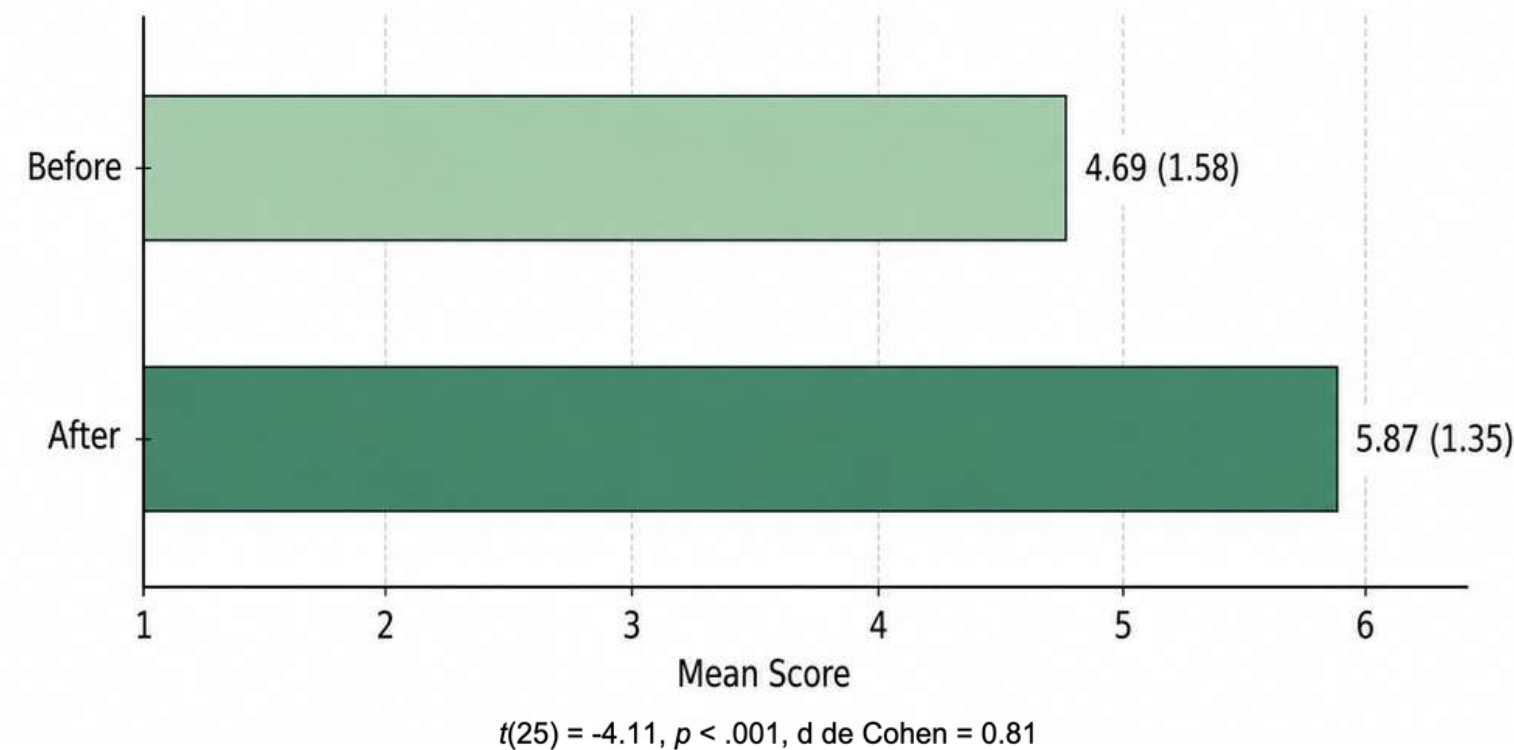

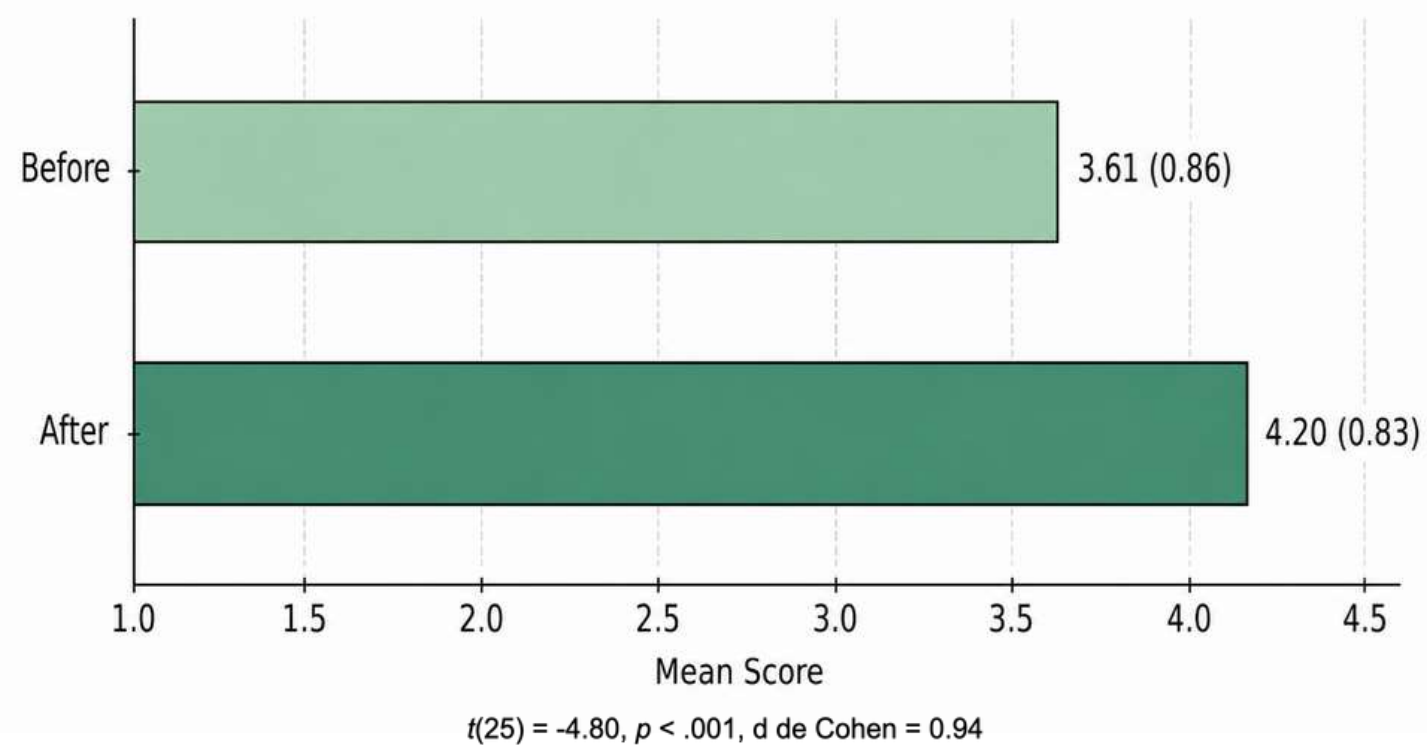

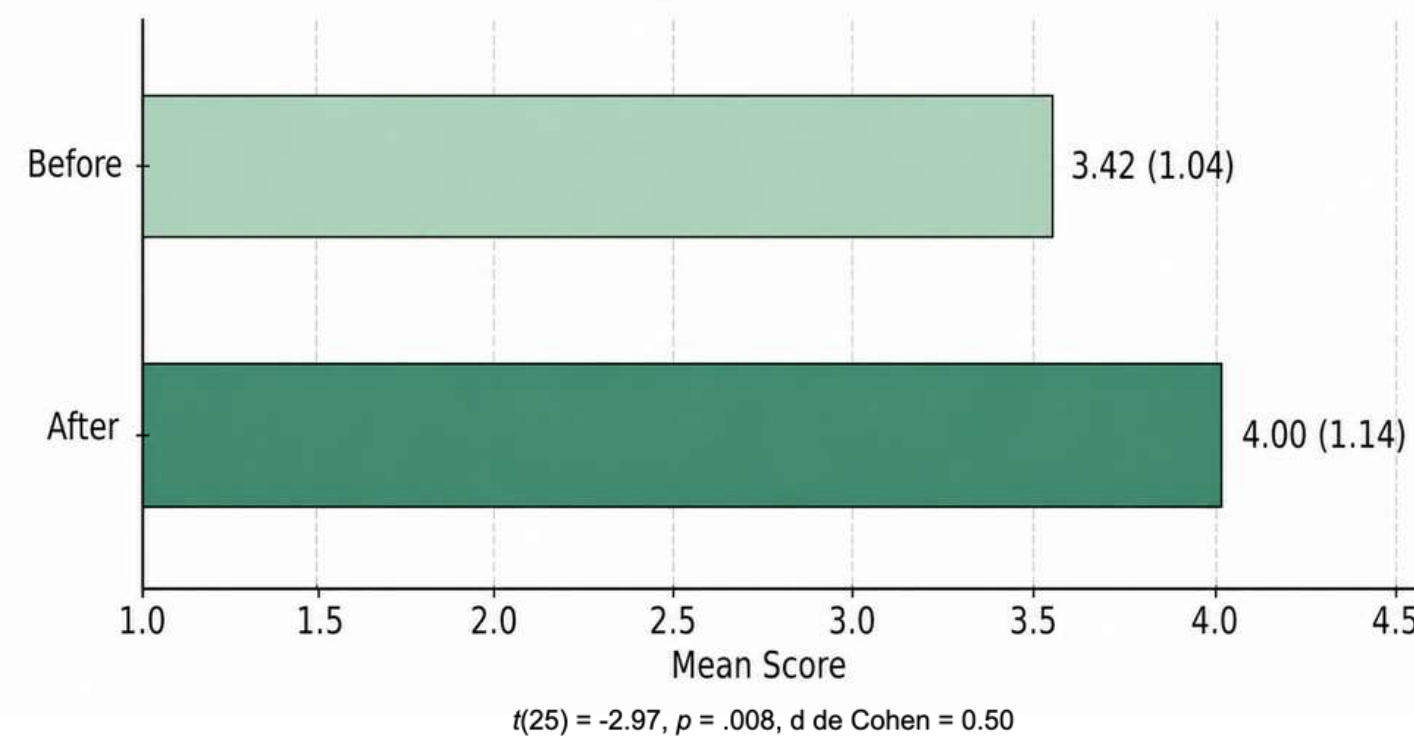

Providing parenting skills

Therapeutic Support:

Helps parents explain their imprisonment to their children and fosters empathy toward caregivers' efforts.

Providing parenting skills

Sports Activities:

***Promote free play without movement restrictions,
enhancing the sense of freedom in normalized
spaces.***

Providing parenting skills

Artistic Activities:

- ***Promote better relationships among participants, reducing stress and increasing relaxation.***
- ***Boost a sense of community and empower participants by sharing their creations both inside and outside of prison.***

***Professional Training:
Enhances workplace well-being, strengthening family
relationships and interest in new parenting dynamics.***

Adaptability of Spaces:

Increases children's well-being during visits and reduces the prison stigma within the family environment.

Family meeting:

Reduces stigma, enhances the sense of freedom for all participants, prevents conflicts, and increases confidence in the system.
